

Tree-top view for Kew visitors

●THE architects behind the London Eye have unveiled plans to build a 60ft-high steel tree-top walkway at the Royal Botanic Gardens in Kew. Bosses hired Marks Barfield after the success of a temporary wooden structure two years ago. The new £3 million, 656ft-long walkway will snake through chestnuts and resemble prehistoric trees. It is hoped it will be ready by May next year.
